How can my family participate? When your family arrives at the G Street entrance of the Smithsonian American Art Museum, look for signs that will direct you to the sign-in table. MCPS art teachers will be there to greet you. You will receive a self-guiding brochure and a map. The self-guided activities are intended to help your family learn to look at and talk about art. It is suggested that you apply these activities to any works of art in the galleries that interest you and your family. You will find permanent collection works, or works that belong to the gallery, and special exhibitions of works on loan from other museums. Feel free to ask museum staff if you need assistance locating a particular work of art.

How can we get there? The Smithsonian American Art Museum is located at 8th and G Streets NW, Washington DC, 20004. Street parking is limited. Taking Metro is highly recommended. RED/YELLOW/GREEN lines: Chinatown – Gallery Place
